## The 18th National Eucharistic Congress of Brazil

The celebration of the 18th National Eucharistic Congress of Brazil was initially scheduled for November 2021 in the Archdiocese of Olinda and Recife. Postponed because of the pandemic restrictions, it will be celebrated from 11 to 15 November 2022 with the theme: "Bread on every table".

The theme draws attention to the ultimate goal of the Eucharist: that the bread and wine shared in the Lord's Supper may bear fruit in people's daily lives and in the sharing of goods and life. The chosen motto, which recalls the primitive Christian community described in the Acts of the Apostles, also points in this direction: "They broke bread with gladness and there were no needy among them".

The focal point for the Congress will be a large commercial building, now being renovated in the centre of the city of Recife, which will house the "House of Bread", where a series of social and spiritual activities for people living on the streets will be concentrated.
